Mr. Bancone joined IBM in February, 1992. He is an Associate General Counsel of IBM currently assigned to Global Technology Services, Americas. As the lead attorney for GTS Americas, Mr. Bancone provides and oversees legal support for the sale and delivery of outsourcing, hosting, and maintenance services in the U.S., Canada, and Latin America.
