

Bio of Dick Thornburgh

Mr. Thornburgh is counsel to the Washington, DC office of Kirkpatrick & Lockhart Nicholson Graham LLP, the law firm which he first joined in 1959. He served as a two-term governor of Pennsylvania, attorney general of the United States under Presidents Reagan and George H. W. Bush and under-secretary general of the United Nations during a public career which spanned more than 25 years. Since rejoining the firm in 1994, his practice has encompassed general corporate matters, governmental affairs advice and the conduct of internal investigations for a variety of clients.

Among other matters, Mr. Thornburgh was the court-appointed examiner in the WorldCom bankruptcy proceedings, the largest in the nation's history, and served as co-chair of the Independent Review Panel appointed by CBS to investigate the *60 Minutes Wednesday* segment concerning President Bush's Texas Air National Guard service.
