Robert Pease is the Deputy Director, Investigations and Enforcement, in the Office of Oversight and Investigations (OMOI). Mr. Pease brings more than 17 years of FERC experience to OMOI, and an additional seven years at the Federal Election Commission.

Prior to being named Deputy Director in May 2004, Mr. Pease was Director of OMOI's Division of Enforcement.

Mr. Pease has been plying his trade within the enforcement divisions of FERC throughout his tenure with the Commission, beginning as a trial attorney in the Office of the General Counsel (OGC) Enforcement Section. He rose to be Deputy Assistant General Counsel in that same office in 1991 and became the Managing Attorney in OGC's Market Oversight and Enforcement division in 2000.

Mr. Pease began his career with the federal government as a litigation attorney for the Federal Election Commission.

Mr. Pease received a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa., and J.D. from Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco.
